## College publishes first scholarship, endowment recognition brochure

The College of Pharmacy is proud to offer its first publication of the 2003-2004 Brochure of Scholarships, Endowments and Fellowships. The brochure was published so others may share in the recognition of the individuals, corporations, foundations and associations that have generously invested in the future of students at the Idaho State University College of Pharmacy.

Copies also have been made available to inform our students of the scholarship and fellowship assistance available to them. In fiscal year 2003-2004, the College awarded approximately \$124,000 in scholarships to nearly 70 students. Scholarship Endowments are simple to establish and by their nature, create a gift that lives in perpetuity.

Following are brief answers to some of the most commonly asked questions regarding endowments.

### **What is an endowment?**

An endowment is a sum of money that is never spent, but is invested to provide a dependable stream of income. Endowments are permanent.

### **How large a donation does an endowment require?**

The minimum amount to officially establish an endowment is \$5,000. This can include matching corporate gifts, or multiple small gifts from friends of the donor and/or the College.

### **I would like to start an endowment, but I am unable to provide the entire \$5,000 at this time. What can I do?**

The ISU Foundation allows donors three years to reach the minimum amount of \$5,000 to start an endowment.

### **Who Can Create an Endowment?**

Anyone may create an endowment. Individuals, foundations, corporations, and various clubs and

organizations have all created successful endowments at Idaho State University.

### **How are scholarship awards made from individual endowments?**

Endowment funds are carefully invested by the ISU Foundation in an effort to maximize growth while ensuring a steady annual award. Each year, an amount equal to 5% of the market value of an endowment is made available for use as scholarships or other support, as designated by the donor. All undistributed endowment income is returned to the principle of the fund so that it will continue to grow.

### **Can I determine what type of student my endowment will benefit?**

Absolutely. Donors provide the ISU Foundation with the guidelines for choosing the recipients of their scholarships. You may specify a certain major, grade point average, participation in a certain activity or club, or any other areas you wish to emphasize. Endowments may also support areas other than scholarships, such as research, endowed professorships, equipment and laboratories, or any type of

department or program support desired by the donor.

### **Will I ever know the recipients of my gift?**

Each year you will receive a letter from the ISU Foundation with information about the student(s) who received your scholarship. In addition, students are provided with information about the donor of the award, and in many cases the donors receive a personal call or letter from students. If you prefer, your gift may be anonymous.
